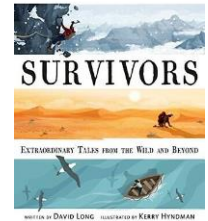
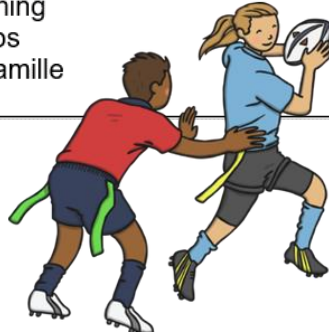
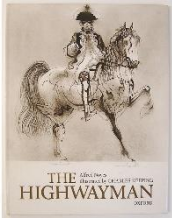
Autumn Term 2023
